Trachea	Windpipe
Air will travel through the trachea, also known as the windpipe.	
Bronchus/Bronchi	Tube leading to the lungs.
The bronchi are the major branches off the trachea leading to the lungs.	
Alveolus/Alveoli	Microscopic air sacs in the lungs.
Larynx	Organ located on top of the trachea that contains the vocal cords.
Respiration	Process of carrying oxygen to cells, getting rid of carbon dioxide, and releasing energy.
Diaphragm	Sheet of muscle below the lungs.
Inhale	To breathe in.
Exhale	To breathe out.
Mucus	Sticky liquid produced in the nose and windpipe.
Cilia	Tiny hairlike structures.
Nicotine	Stimulant found in tobacco.

Excretion	Process of removing waste products from the body.
Kidney	Organ that removes waste products from the blood.
Ureter	Tube that carries liquid waste from the kidneys to the bladder.
Urine	Liquid waste formed in the kidneys.
Urea	Nitrogen compound formed as a waste product.
Nephron	Filtering structure of the kidneys.
Dermis	Inner layer of skin.
Epidermis	Outer layer of skin.
Perspiration	Waste water and salts that leave the body through the skin.
Pore	Tiny opening in the skin.
Evaporation	Changing of a liquid to a gas.
